visa validation

Agents of the office Français de l'Immigration et de l'Intégration (OFII) will register your OFII application in order to validate your visa **if you live in Paris** and if you have a "Long stay visa equivalent to a residence permit" (ref: R311-3 6° or 9° of the CESEDA). This process is mandatory and must be carried out within 3 months after arriving in France.
